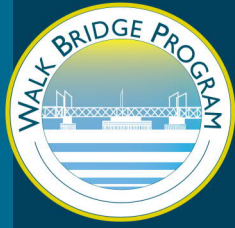
Drainage Upgrades on [Goldstein Place](#)
